Physical Education:

PE lessons will take place on Tuesdays and Fridays. All children must keep their PE kit in school. Full PE kit consists of: white T-shirt/polo shirt, black shorts/joggers/leggings, and trainers or pumps. This term our PE will be Tennis and athletics.

Reading & Phonics:



We encourage all children to read 3 times per week across school. We ask that you simply record in your child's reading record when they have read each week so that we can keep track. Children then need to bring their reading record into school every day as adults in school will hear them read in their phonics reading groups and will sign their reading record. On


a Friday morning, children that have read 3 times during the week will receive a stamp on their reading reward chart.

Maths:

In Year 2 we will be learning about time, fractions and measurement as well as revising the skills previously taught to prepare children for SATs Assessments. In Year 1 we will be learning how to solve one step multiplication and division problems using physical resources to support. We will then move on to fractions, finding a half and a quarter of shapes and amounts. In the later part of summer term, we will be looking at geometry - position and direction before moving on to place value within 100, and exploring money and time.

English Novel Study:

This term our Novel study book is 'Fantastic Mr Fox' by Roald Dahl. The children are familiar with many of Roald Dahl's stories and we are so excited to get stuck into this one. We will be exploring character description and creating our own farmers before moving on to writing non-chronological reports about foxes, instructions of how to catch a fox and finally, our own narrative, creating our own ending to the story!

Science:

In Science we will be learning about forces, sound and Space. As part of our Science learning we will be having a planetarium visit to school in in the final half term. More details to follow!



Religious Education:

We will be learning about Islam and Christianity. We will look at different celebrations and how religions celebrate events, We will learn about the differences and similarities in how Christians and Muslims celebrate. After half term, we will be finding out about inspirational leaders. We will learn about who Christians and Muslims follow and who they find inspirational. We will also find out what the role of a leader does in a religious place of worship.

Art:

We are excited to begin our summer term learning looking at Keith Haring's pop art. We will begin with sketching a simple figure using pencil then black pen. We will explore how Keith Haring uses lines to press movement. We will then use acrylic paint to create bold clean colours and create colour palettes our final piece. After half term we will learn to draw



portraits using pencil and charcoal. We will study Pablo Picasso towards the end of the summer term, where we will learn how Picasso created distorted images of faces, completely opposite to traditional styles. The children will copy an image they have drawn onto




polyblock and create a print. They will build up a series of prints to create a set of images in the style of Picasso.



History/

In the first half term we will continue our theme of Australia.

In the second half term we will move onto a study of London in Geography and in History we will be looking at the Great Fire of London. As part of our learning about London and the Great Fire on London, we will be holding a theme day in the Final half term where we will do artwork focused on the fire, bake bread and pastries that may have been baked at the time of the fire and other fun activities linked to our History and Geography learning.
