## Kit List for Whitby 2024

This is a suggested list of items for your child to take. It would be helpful if items are marked with your child's name.

- Water bottle
- Rucksack for carrying belongings around during the day that will fit an A4 book (the bag will need to be carried so will need to have 2 sturdy straps)
- Waterproof jacket
- Strong footwear/trainers for walking (plus a spare pair in case of wet feet)
- Socks (including enough for a change of socks in case of wet feet)
- Trousers for outdoors (track-suit/jogging bottoms/jeans)
- Shorts (depending on the weather)
- Warm jumpers/sweatshirts
- Underwear for 3 days
- Nightwear
- Slippers/dressing gown
- Comb/hair-brush
- Washing items, eg. shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, shower gel and deodorant
- Large towel for the shower
- Spare towel for use on the beach
- Bag for dirty washing
- Sun cream & sun hat
- All small, select amount of snacks
- Empty packed lunch box
- Any medication needed please note this <u>must</u> be named and given to a member of staff on the day of departure with a signed form.

## Personal Belongings

Mobile phones and smart watches **will not** be permitted on the trip. If your child would like to take a camera (fully charged), they can bring one to take photos during the visit. Children may take personal belongings, but they will be expected to be responsible for their own property. These might include the following items: small game e.g. travel game (non-electronic), book/magazine, teddy/mascot, torch, own pencils/pens/crayons, cameras. Whilst every effort would be made to recover a lost item, the school **cannot** be held responsible.

## Additional Information

- Around a month before the trip, you will receive a form to complete which asks you to detail all emergency contact information as well as any medical/dietary information for your child.
- If your child suffers from travel sickness, medication should be taken prior to departure. Any additional doses required <u>must</u> be handed in for use on the return journey.
- All medication (including inhalers) MUST be clearly labelled with your child's name and handed in to the designated adult on the day of departure.
- Mobile phones are not to be taken.
- Your child is allowed to take a maximum of £10 spending money which should be placed in a purse/wallet clearly labelled with your child's name. School **cannot** accept any responsibility for lost money.
