## KS2 PRODUCTION TICKETS 2024

Hi all,



It's only a few weeks until our KS2 Summer Production of 'What a Knight!'. Rehearsals are well under way and the children are busy learning their lines, dances and songs. You're in for a treat!

Showtimes:

Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> July @ 1.30pm -featuring Y6, Y5 & Y3

Wednesday 10th July @ 5:30pm - featuring Y6, Y5 & Y3

Thursday 11th July @ 1.30pm - featuring Y6, Y5 & Y4

Thursday 11th July @ 5:30pm - featuring Y6, Y5 & Y4

The procedures for ticket sales and entry to the event are the same as last year.

The first stage is for parents/carers to request up to 2 tickets per child in years 3-6 (one form per child please) for the performance / performances of your choice by filling in the google form below.

There is also the opportunity to fill in a '2nd choice' option of tickets in case we cannot accommodate your initial request due to demand. We naturally have a lot more requests for evening tickets but the same limited seating available.

Finally, you can indicate on this form if you wish to request additional tickets beyond your allocation of 2 should any spare tickets be available once initially allocated. These will be very limited.

Tickets are priced at £2 each, which includes entry to the performance and a show programme. All monies raised will go towards school fund for resources for the children and further props and equipment for future performances.

The google form (LINK HERE: <u>https://forms.gle/pRuCAfFaXtMPHBYX7</u>) will go live at 6pm this evening and closes on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July in the evening. You will be informed on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July of which tickets you have been allocated.

You will then receive a message informing you that a new payment has been setup on parentpay. You will need to pay for the number of tickets you have been allocated by choosing the appropriate quantity on parentpay.

Tickets are allocated in the following way. Requests from parents/carers of Y6 children are prioritised 1st due to the Y6 children taking on the main acting roles in the show. All other requests will be allocated based on a 1st come 1st served basis, using the time stamp from when you complete your google form.





No paper tickets will be issued, but a list of children who have had tickets paid for will be on a register on entry to the performance, where parents/carers attending will be signed in.
