Autumn Term

Our learning will cover Living Things in Science, our Geography learning question is 'Where does our food come from?' and in History, we will learn about the Stone Age to Iron Age period. We will also be reading Krindlekrax as our class novel.

Spring/Summer

In Spring term, our learning moves onto Earth and Space in Science, the Arctic and Antarctic in Geography and studying The Ancient Greeks for History.

Our final term's learning will cover Plants and Technology within Science, The Romans is a great unit for History and in Geography, we will be undertaking a study of a European city; Naples in Italy.
