Meet your Teacher

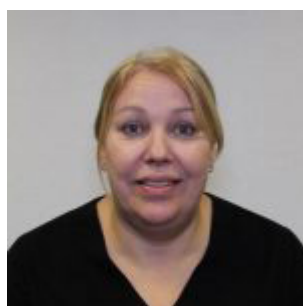


Mr Steeple
