Physical Education:

Our PE teacher is Mr Inglis who teaches the children their PE lessons on Monday mornings. All children must come to school in their PE kit on that day. Full PE kit consists of: white T-shirt/polo shirt, black shorts/joggers/leggings, and trainers or pumps.

Reading & Phonics

Phonics sessions are taught daily in FS2. Our school uses the phonics scheme 'Little Wandle'. As a school, we have invested in a number of resources, including decodable reading books, that your children will be begin to take home later this term. As these are relatively new, we would greatly appreciate if you could encourage your child to take good care of them. This term, we will be focusing on blending and segmenting, plus starting to learn the first few sets of sounds from phase 2. We encourage the children to segment to help them clearly segment the sounds which they then blend to read the words. The children will soon be assessed on their reading skills before they begin to bring home appropriate books to the sounds that they are learning.



Maths:

In maths, we will begin to compare numbers, look at patterns and recognise similarities and differences. The children will look at the composition of numbers to 10.

English:

The children will become familiar with lots of authors. The stories will be based around woodland animals and settings. We will have a big push on writing our names and encourage lots of mark making.



Jigsaw (PSHE):

We will begin by introducing the children to 'Paws'.

Understanding the World:

The children will talk about family and explain who is the oldest and youngest. We will be exploring the woods and looking at how trees change and leaves fall during Autumn. The children will talk about seasonal changes. As part of our learning, we will talk about some animals that are 'nocturnal'.
