## Wednesday 18th December: Carols in the community

Please note—due to the KS2 children rehearsing the carols, we will prioritise entry to the church for KS2 children and their families due to limited pace.

Any money raised will be split between the charities Save the Children, Sheffield Children's Hospital Charity (our snow-flake) and Rotherham Hospice. The Santa dash is part of a national initiative to get children active and have some fun doing so. Children will complete one of several mapped out routes at their own pace and will even have a visit from Father Christmas himself running along with them for encouragement and motivation.
