- Accommodation 2 nights
- Travel (coach)
- Food throughout the trip (3 meals – breakfast, lunch and tea)
- All trips
- Insurance for the 3 days

Accommodation

- Just on the racecourse which we have access to using a private path from the hostel
- Large dining room
- Separate 'chill out' space where we will be able to run evening activities, including a large TV screen
- All rooms sleep 2-4 people
- En-suite bedrooms
- All rooms will be single sex
- We'll be asking children for room preferences before we go and then will be sharing these with the children once we arrive.



Accommodation

- Stableside will be providing us with all of our meals- the only food the children will need is a packed lunch for day 1 .
- There will be various options to choose from at breakfast.
- Lunch will be a packed lunch: sandwich with a snack and drink
- Evening meals we'll be having in the dining hall when we're back from our day's activities.







Safety and information



- They are all en-suite rooms, so children have their privacy.
- The hostel are used to school groups and have schools staying all year round
- We will be the only school on our floor which will be securely locked
- Front door will be locked at night and there is 24 hour security at reception.
- Adults will be spread out along the corridor/ over both floors should we have access to both
- The adult keys can access any room in the hostel.

- Throughout the visit, we'll be regularly sharing updates with you via our Class Dojo pages
- We will be contactable via Dojo; however, if you need to get in touch with us more urgently during school hours, contact the school office who will then get in touch with us. If you need to urgently get in touch with us out of school hours, we will share with you a school mobile number to be used in emergencies.

How will we get around?



- 30-40 minute walk into the centre depending on the attraction we are going to.
- Our coach will drop us off and pick us up on the first and last day
- We will be taking the bus on the second day to return to the hostel
- All attractions are close together in the centre.
- We will be split off into small groups; each group with an adult.

Departure Day/ Return to school

- On the day we leave for York, we ask that the children arrive at school for 8:10am so that we are registered and ready to leave by 8:30am.
- Children will need a packed lunch and water bottle for the first day- all other food will be provided.
- We will then be returning to school on the children's final day for around 4pm- updates will be given via Dojo.

- ✓ See kit list for information (**this will include a waterproof jacket and trousers due to time of year**)
- ✓ Maximum spending money of £15 which should be labelled with your child's name in a purse/wallet (school cannot be responsible for children's items/money)

- No** electronic equipment – i.e. ipads, smart watches etc
